

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) CREDIT

Passing scores (3, 4, or 5) on certain CEEB Advanced Placement (AP) Tests taken prior to admission to the College of Environmental Design may be used to satisfy specific College requirements as shown below. Note that if the student takes a course for which AP credit has already been given, duplicated units may be deducted.
