# Spring Semester deliverables [due: May 20, 2019]

The following deliverables must be completed by the end of the Spring semester preceding the final year. This form and the rest of the deliverables should be combined into a single composite PDF and submitted using the Google Form that will be provided. (*Note: Students not submitting these deliverables will be expected to pursue the Final Comprehensive Studio option.*)

1. An abstract of approximately 500 words detailing the proposed independent research project that has been presented to the potential committee members whose signatures appear below.

2A: For those pursuing a University Thesis: A written narrative that includes a description of the primary research topic, one primary research question, a list of key literature sources, the proposed study area, and a description of potential anticipated research methods and project deliverable(s).

<u>2B</u>: *For those pursing a Professional Project Report*: A written narrative that includes a description of the primary research topic, a list of key literature sources and precedents, identification of potential client and study area, and a description of the potential outcome(s)/deliverables of project.

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3. A signature of commitment from the Committee Chair. Signatures of conditional agreement from the other committee members may be provided but are not required for this submittal. (*Note: in lieu of a signature on this form, a committee member may send the student an email stating their commitment.* This email should be included in the composite PDF submitted to the Google Form.)

For those pursuing a University Thesis: The committee is comprised of 3 UC Berkeley ladder-rank faculty, including 1 LAEP faculty as Chair, 1 LAEP faculty as Member, and 1 faculty from another department as Academic Senate Representative (ASR) Member. (*Notes: LAEP faculty holding joint appointments in another department may serve as the ASR. When necessary, and approved, the committee can consist of 3 LAEP faculty.*)

For those pursuing a Professional Project Report: The committee is comprised of 1 LAEP ladder-rank faculty as Chair, and 1 member who is a ladder-rank faculty in LAEP or a related department. If the student wants, a third member from outside the University community (generally a person involved in the project such as a client or professional) may also be included on the committee.

Note: The commitment of the committee signing below is contingent upon satisfactory completion of additional deliverables due August 15, 2019.
