### Landscape Architecture & Environmental Planning at the University of California, Berkeley

The Department of Landscape Architecture & Environmental Planning (LAEP) at UC Berkeley offers three **Master of Landscape Architecture (M.L.A.)** degree tracks that are structured to equip students with advanced design and planning skills. All three tracks are accredited by the Landscape Architecture Accreditation Board (LAAB).

- The three-year M.L.A. degree track (MLA 3D) is the first professional degree for students with non-design backgrounds.
- The two-year M.L.A. degree track (MLA 2D) is the second professional degree for those students with first degrees in landscape architecture, architecture, or environmental design.
- The two-year M.L.A. in environmental planning (MLA EP) is for students with a strong background in the environmental sciences or management.

The MLA 2D and the MLA EP are also accredited as degree programs with advanced standing in the LAAB accredited MLA.
